ITPO/RTI/Appeal/10/03/2018	Being not content with the information provided by DPIO, ITPO, the applicant/appellant filed 1st Appeal dated 26.04.2019 before the First Appellate Authority, ITPO stating that “- Provided Incomplete, Misleading or false information. The reply which you have provided is incomplete and misleading. So once again I kindly request you to provide me the correct information.”	<p>The First Appellate Authority after having perused the RTI application/replies and 1<sup>st</sup> Appeal of the Appellant ruled that the requisite Information has already been furnished to the appellant corresponding to the queries raised in his RTI application.</p> <p>Also, the First Appellate Authority, ITPO observed that the appellant has submitted the Appeal beyond the stipulated period of 30 days; (more than five months). Moreover, the appellant has not cited any reasons for delay in filing the 1<sup>st</sup> Appeal. Hence, it cannot be considered at this stage.</p> <p>With these remarks, the appeal stands disposed of.</p>

As per section 7(1) of the RTI Act, the information was to be provided as expeditiously as possible, and in any case within thirty days of the receipt of the request.
