

Rules of Allocation of Halls

Halls are allotted after checking the status of booking and keeping in view the following:

- (g) Slots for all regular events are reserved.
- (h) Optimum Utilization of Halls.
- (i) In case of competing demands, applications are considered on first-come-first served basis subject to payment of advance license fee as per the approved schedule.
- (j) B2B events will be given preference over B2C events.
- (k) Job and Education related events should have emphasis on export orientation/services relating to export. They should be held in the lean period.
- (l) Time gap between an ITPO fair and a third party fair of similar product profile should be 3 days before and after. However, no fair on similar product profile is to be held concurrently in Pragati Maidan by third party organizer. (Amended vide circular No. 144-ITPO)624)/MKTG/2012 dated May 20, 2013).
