#### "Para 2.ii): Superannuation Benefit:

The ceiling of 30% towards superannuation benefits would be calculated on Basic Pay plus DA instead of Basic Pay alone. Any superannuation benefit will be under a "defined contribution scheme" and not under a "defined benefit scheme". CPSEs that do not have superannuation scheme may develop such scheme and obtain the approval of their Administrative Ministry. However, no other superannuation benefit can be granted outside this 30% ceiling (Para 12, Annex IV(v) of O.M. dated 26.11.2008 refers)".

As per Para 2.ii) above -After taking into account payment of PF and Gratuity of 12% and 4.8% respectively of the ceiling of 30%, the balance of 13.2% was to cover the "Pension" and the "Post-retirement Medical" Schemes in line with DPE guidelines and the same is learnt was proposed for the kind consideration of ITPO Management in February 2016. The break- up initially proposed for earmarking in the Pension and Post-Retirement Medical Schemes of ITPO as learnt, was to be 9% and 4% respectively. Incidentally, the DPE guidelines in the matter were subject to the rider that after allocation of 30% of basic pay and DA as superannuation benefits for its employees, the profit before tax (PBT) of the CPSE concerned should not go down by more than 20% in the year 2007-08.

The audited account of ITPO for the year 2007-08 (the reference year as per DPE guidelines) showed a PBT of Rs.68.59 crores, leaving a scope for a ceiling amount of Rs.13.71 crore to be accommodated under Superannuation benefits of employees in accordance with the DPE guidelines. The employer's contribution in the Pension of retirees of ITPO has been merely 7% against proposed one of 9%.
